- Be currently admitted as a matriculated (degree seeking) student.
- Be registered with the Center for Disability Services, and be found eligible for services under the University ADA standards.
- Submit an academic transcript from all colleges attended if you are a college student or from your high school if you are an entering freshman. **Minimum 2.5 GPA required**
- Provide one letter of recommendation from someone acquainted with your academic record.
- Provide a copy of your most recent tax returns or a financial statement.
- Submit in writing your academic goals and participation in community organizations.

Scholarship Information:

- Applicant must have received an official letter of acceptance from the University of Utah as a matriculated student (degree seeking) by March 13, 2009. Please contact the Admission Office to begin this admission process.
- The Center for Disability Services has been designated by the University of Utah as the official office to provide accommodations to students that qualify under the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504. To be eligible for consideration of scholarships the applicant must be registered with CDS and found eligible for services. Please contact CDS to meet with an advisor.
- Applicant must provide a transcript from any and all colleges you may have attended as a student or from your high school if you are an entering freshman. Minimum 2.5 GPA required.
- Applicant must submit a copy of the most recent tax returns or personnel statement of financial need, as well as a statement of academic goals, and participation in community organizations.
- This scholarship is a cash award for fall and spring semester. The recipient must maintain a 2.5 GPA to retain the scholarship. The student may take as many credit hours as desired.
- The selection committee will be comprised of staff members from the Department of Student Affairs. A weighted formula of grade point average, financial need, community participation, academic goals, and a letter of recommendation will be considered in the selection process. All applicants will be notified by May 1st via mail.

Note: If needed you are encouraged to contact both departments immediately to allow suitable time to meet the scholarship requirements.
