The Center for Disability & Access (CDA) is pleased to offer several scholarships for students with a disability. The current available scholarships include*:

- Louise J. Snow Scholarship for any qualified student with a disability
- Keaton Walker Scholarship for students with a visual (preferred) or physical disability
- Poulson Family Endowed Scholarship for students with a visual (preferred) or physical disability
- Ann Margaret Christenson Scholarship for students with cerebral palsy (preferred) or another neurological disorder

Scholarship amounts will vary between \$1000 - \$5000 depending on funding available. For additional information about CDA scholarships, visit https://disability.utah.edu/students/scholarships.php

To be considered for the scholarship(s), you must:

	Submit a typed personal statement to include: academic and career goals, how you have used your disability as an example in a positive way, what volunteer or community service you have participated in and financial need.	
	Submit an academic transcript (official or unofficial) from all colleges attended if you are a college student or from your high school if you are an entering freshman. A My Degree Dashboard report is acceptable for University of Utah Students.	
	Provide one letter of recommendation from someone acquainted with your academic record (not a family member).	
	Complete a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) application. Here is the link: https://fafsa.ed.gov .	
Additional criteria include:		
	Admitted as a current matriculated (degree seeking) student by March 1, 2019.	
	Registered with the Center for Disability & Access (CDA), and be found eligible for services. If you are not currently registered, please contact CDA to meet with an advisor.	
	Minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA required.	
	Recipients must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA and achieve a 2.5 GPA each semester for	
	the term of the scholarship. Enrolling less than full-time requires approval from CDA.	
	All submitted materials and the above criteria will be considered in the selection process.	

All applicants will be notified by May 1st.
